In September 2008, TTT's nonprofit partner WILMA (World Institute for Leadership and Management in Africa) began to design an **academic program** that will recruit and train student leaders to work on **sustainable, community-based projects** in developing countries.

The SEED course (Social Enterprise and Entrepreneurship for Development) will be an intensive two-week overview of business planning and management skills for college students who wish to transform their home regions through **social entrepreneurship**. The University of Arizona and Swarthmore College are SEED host candidates.

Jojoba cooperative in Egypt

The first WILMA Joint Venture Commercial Estate in Egypt is starting in the desert near Assiut, a city on the Nile in Upper Egypt.

WILMA's local partner, Mr. Yousef Sadek, is founder of the jojoba cooperative Organic Jojoba Egypt. His latest company extracts a commercially valuable ester from **jojoba seeds**, for use in cosmetics and as an extreme-pressure additive in automotive applications.

With over 20 years' experience in agribusiness, Sadek (right in photo) has created a network of 30 jojoba farms that produces about 20 metric tons of jojoba seed annually. This cooperative

will be working with SEED students described above.

TTT and its partner WILMA are ready to facilitate needed **technology transfer** from leading researchers and jojoba companies in Europe and the U.S.

Zambia creating zone for Food Processing

TTT-Zambia Food Processing Development Company , which joined TTT this year, is working on a business plan for a food-processing commercial farm.

This new project is for a vertically integrated farming operation with production on 10,000 hectares (24,700 acres) of land. Leadership has already identified land for the farm.

The farm plans to produce **canola, wheat, maize and soybeans**. The business plan details the installation of a soya-canola processing plant, a wheat milling plant and a 10 MW combined cycle power plant. All products are for consumption rather than biofuels, from the baking flour to the cooking oil produced, says Jonathan Majula, the project leader.
