2) NEW TTT PROJECTS: AFRICA BIOFUEL AND EMISSION REDUCTION COMPANY:

Initially focused on East Africa, this TTT-WILMA spinoff company, headquartered in Dar es Salaam/Tanzania, and co-owned by the National Investments Company of Tanzania, is developing 60,000 hectares of land in the Biharamulo District/Kagera region of Tanzania, with 12 million CROTON MEGALOCARPUS trees, and derive from their nuts over 100 million liters of biodiesel per year at its refinery. Focused on sustainable economic and social development, this project will be eligible for Carbon Credits under the Clean Development Mechanism of the Kyoto Protocol. This project will also become part of the portfolio of the TTT Africa Fund.
